Permanent residents of the following counties are assessed a "contiguous counties" rate:
Indiana: Clark, Crawford, Floyd, Harrison, Perry, Posey, Spencer, Vanderburg and Warrick
Ohio: Adams**, Brown**, Clermont**, Gallia, Hamilton**, Lawrence and Scioto
(**only those accepted into the Associate Degree Nursing program)

Permanent residents of the following Indiana counties are assessed an "in-state" rate: Dearborn, Franklin, Jefferson, Ohio, Ripley and Switzerland

Security Charge

The Kentucky Community and Technical College System Board of Regents, which determines tuition and charges for all colleges in the system including Gateway, has approved a security charge of \$40 per semester for on-campus Gateway students. Gateway will apply the charge for the first time beginning with the Fall 2010 semester. The charge **will not apply** to the following types of students: Corrections, Fire Rescue (off campus), Workforce Development (off campus), Dual Credit/High School, Mandatory Waiver students, (Donavan, Foster, KIA, etc.), KCTCS Faculty and Staff, KCTCS Spouse/Dependent, On-line only students.

Recent employee and student surveys at Gateway have indicated that safety and security ranked as top priorities among students and employees. The charge will allow Gateway to fund a comprehensive security program at all campuses. The security charge will be used to hire a full-time safety director and additional security personnel, provide training, increase electronic monitoring on all campuses and implement emergency management processes, including improved collaboration with local police and fire departments. The charge will be collected at the same time as tuition; students receiving financial aid will be able to pay the charge with financial aid awards.
