GATEWAY COMMUNITY & TECHNICAL COLLEGE BOARD MEMBERS' RESPONSIBILITIES

Board members are volunteers who have responded to a "call to serve" and have accepted a gubernatorial appointment, or have been duly elected in accordance with the GCTC Board of Directors' Bylaws for a term of service. Each member will approach the task with a sincere and energetic commitment to contribute what he/she can to advance the field of higher education for their community. Some may be able to do more than others; but their collective capabilities and contributions should be able to make a demonstrable impact as measured by the Board's annual self-assessment.

In conjunction with the mission of the Bylaws, each Board member has the following responsibility to:

- 1. Be committed to the work of the college and the KCTCS organization.
- 2. Utilize their specific expertise for the greater good of the Board and organization.
- 3. Be available to serve on one or more Standing or Special Committees.
- 4. Participate in Board discussions.
- 5. Ensure that all Board members are treated fairly and with respect.
- 6. Be familiar with the Board's Bylaws, adhering to the policies and rules.
- 7. Prepare thoroughly for all Board meetings by reading the material sent out in advance.
- 8. Assist with the overall tasks undertaken by the Board, including work that goes beyond preparing and attending meetings.
- 9. Commit to attend at least 75 percent of all Board and Committee meetings.
- 10. Participate in the process that assesses the Board's own performance annually.
- 11. Participate in the evaluation of the President/CEO of GCTC.
- 12. Support and attend, whenever possible, special events at GCTC.
