BOARD RESPONSIBILITIES

The responsibilities of the Board of Directors are clearly defined in the Bylaws of the Board. They include fulfilling the mission as established in KRS 164.600, as amended by HB1, First Extraordinary Session 1997 and the Kentucky Community and Technical College System Board of Regents' policies. The responsibilities of the Board of Directors of GCTC are detailed in Article II of the Bylaws and are as follows:

1. Recommend one (1) candidate for College President/Chief Executive Officer from three (3) candidates provided by the President of the KCTCS. The President shall have the authority to make the final appointment and shall not be bound by the recommendation from the Board of Directors.
2. Evaluate the College President/CEO and advise the KCTCS President of his or her performance. The President of the KCTCS has final authority for the appointment and termination of the College President/CEO.
3. Approve budget requests for recommendation to KCTCS.
4. Adopt and amend an annual operating budget and submit it (through appropriate channels) to the Board of Regents of KCTCS for approval as to compliance with its guidelines.
5. Approve a strategic, long-range plan that is developed in coordination with local employers, civic leaders, campus constituents, and other postsecondary institutions in the region and that is consistent with the strategic agenda of the General Assembly.
